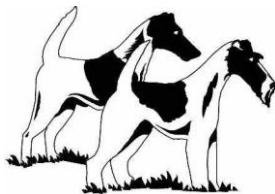

Entry method: first received. Each test is limited to 125 entries. Entries received prior to the opening date will be treated as invalid & will be returned to sender. Entries will be acknowledged by email if legible email is provided on the entry form. Entries WILL be accepted for All American Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program Dogs may only run once per test. All entries must be accompanied with a check to be valid. Checks will be cashed after closing. A returned check is not a valid entry.

Incomplete, unsigned, or conditional entries will not be allowed. Day of Test entries are allowed if the trial has not filled. Day of show entries will be accepted at the show site on a first come first served basis- day of test entry is not guaranteed. If entry is sent via Next Day Air (UPS), FedEx, Airborne Express, etc. please indicate that no signature is necessary upon arrival, or entry may not be accepted

Continuous Loop / Bag Lure (white plastic bag)
100 yard grass course with minimum 40' run out area.

Exhibitors may present personal lure/squawkers to the lure operator for approval. They may be allowed at his discretion. All lures/squawkers must comply with AKC rules.

The show grounds are partially fenced. The FAST CAT course will be completely fenced with plastic fencing. The track and run out are on grass. Please help keep the grounds clean by picking up after yourself and your dog. Dispose of "poop" bags in the trash containers provided at the site. Please keep your crating area, the test site and grounds clean so that we may continue to be welcomed at these facilities.

Schedule

These will be CONCURRENT tests using a BLOCK SCHEDULE

NO RUN ORDER will be mailed out – a time block will be assigned and a run order will be created within the time block. All entries with a valid, legible email address will be sent an entry confirmation. **Dogs not checked in within 15 minutes of the start of their block time may be moved to a later time block.**

Grounds will be available one hour prior to test hours. Test hours are 9:00 AM until 4:00 PM or until all runs are completed. It is also the responsibility of each entrant to be ready with catcher and releaser when their dog is called to the line. We have a limited number of volunteers; please consider asking fellow entrants to catch/release if you are coming alone. A lunch break will be taken from 12-1pm. **LAST CHECK IN BEFORE LUNCH IS 11:45**

Roll Call

Roll call is the time when participants are expected to check in. Check-in is followed by inspection for fitness, lameness, or “in season” females. Every dog must be inspected prior to EACH run. Handler will wipe female dogs. Roll call will open 15 minutes before your block is scheduled to run. If you do not check in within one hour of the event closing, we will assume you are absent. There are no refunds for absent dogs. Dogs excused at check-in will have entry fees refunded. Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to events and entry fees will be refunded. Please do not bring ill or injured dogs to the test site, but contact the secretary in advance for further options.

Eligibility

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs **at least 12 months of age** that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.

Conditions of entry

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at a greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test if they feel the dog's condition makes the dog unfit to run, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. A minimum wait time of 10 minutes is recommended between runs.

AKC ranking

The *Fast Cat Top 20 Fastest Dogs* are listed by breed on the AKC website. Dogs will appear on this list when they have completed 3 Fast CAT runs.

What is the Fast CAT?

- Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.
- Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.
- Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles per Hour (MPH). Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied and points are earned:
- Handicap:
 - 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
 - 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
 - Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0.
- Titles are earned at specific point levels
 - BCAT = 150 points
 - DCAT = 500 points
 - FCAT = 1,000 points
 - FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

FORMULA

$$204.545/\text{TIME} = \text{MPH}$$

$$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS}$$

ACCORDING TO AKC RULES: Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run but must remain either at the start or finish area of the course. Dogs are not to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. NO mechanical devices including whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. or toys including the waving of objects can be used to lure the dog to the finish line. A toy may be used to help catch the dog but must not be visible to the dog during the run. There must be a catcher in the catch pen. Dogs cannot be recalled to the start line after the run.

All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.

Trial Information

- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- **All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.**
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
- \$5.00 fee may be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore the Huntmaster is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, the Huntmaster has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- MCFTC reserves the right to remove any dog in distress in a parked vehicle or crate.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the MCFTC or its members and representatives.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event and there is very limited shade at the test site. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water. Shade tents, crates, etc. may be left over night at owner's risk.
- An electronic timing system will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be marked off with plastic fencing.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Any dog that eliminates on course will receive a non-qualifying (NQ) score.
- Muzzles are allowed. No pinch/prong collars, and no electronic training collars or devices are allowed. The club recommends using a plain buckle collar and lead.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/MCFTC/DDOM/ dog(s) or person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, may be disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded**.
- There will be a minimum \$25 returned check charge

To: Disc Dogs of Michigan LLC

I wish to use the dog pool, training course, obstacle course, lure course, agility course, frisbee fields, and other recreational facilities and land at the Disc Dogs of Michigan facility (the "Facilities"), for and during training, private use sessions, competitions, club-related competitions and activities, lessons, leagues, and other events and times (collectively the "Events"). In using any, some or all of the Facilities for any one of more of the Events, I recognize and fully understand certain things, including:

- (a) there will be no lifeguard or other safety monitor, guard, rescue personnel, or protector on duty for any of the Facilities;
- (b) my use and my pet's use of the Facilities during Events involves certain risks, including but not limited to: the risk of injury resulting from possible malfunction of the equipment and structures at the Facilities; the risk of injuries resulting from tripping or falling over obstacles at the Facilities; the risk of injuries resulting from unsupervised pool users colliding; the risk of other injuries resulting from participating in the Events and using the Facilities.

I recognize and fully understand that the above list is not a complete or exhaustive list of all possible risks; the list only provides examples of types of risks that I am assuming for my pets and me.

In exchange for Disc Dogs of Michigan LLC allowing my pets and me to participate in Events and use the Facilities, I hereby agree to the conditions below. I fully intend and choose to give up the legal rights, as stated below:

- 1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I have or may have in the future against Disc Dogs of Michigan LLC, its directors, officers, members, employees, agents, or representatives (hereinafter referred to as the "Releases") relating to my participation in the Events and use of the Facilities; and I will not sue any or all of the Releases for any injury or damage to person or property (including pets) arising from or in connection with participation in Events or use of the Facilities;
- 2. TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury, expense, or other cost that I may suffer or that my next of kin may suffer or that my pets or other property may suffer in connection with my participation in the Events and use of the Facilities due to any cause whatsoever, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES;
